HONS 260, Britain in the Tudor Era. Politics, personalities and religion in early Modern Britain. 3 Credits. Satisfies goal 5.

<u>HONS 231, Contemporary Britain.</u> Analysis of contemporary social, political and economic conditions of England, with emphasis on Northumberland. This course fulfills general education requirements. 3 credits. Satisfies goal 6 and Diversity Credit.

<u>HONS 240, Aspects of Medieval English Society</u>. Study of English society in the middle ages (approximately 1066-1485) making specific reference to the rich heritage of this period to be found in Northumbria. 3 credits. Satisfies goal 6.

<u>SW 195 - Social Welfare and Democratic Citizenship.</u> Democratic citizenship and social welfare, state institutions and citizen engagement locally, nationally and globally. 3 Cr. Satisfies Goal 9.

<u>CEEP 262 - Human Growth and Development.</u> A life-span approach to growth and development; physical, intellectual, emotional, and social phases as related to total growth. 3 Cr. Satisfies Goal 5.

<u>CSD 230 - Global Perspectives on Communication Disorders.</u> Comparative perspectives and understanding of communication disorders around the globe; the intersection of educational and health issues with communication disorders. 3 Cr. Satisfies Goal 8.
