CANCELLATION POLICY: Students who withdraw from the program 60 days prior to departure will receive a full refund less the application fee and non-recoverable costs. There will be a cancellation fee for all withdrawals from International Programs after the 60-day limit described above. Students who withdraw from the program fewer than 60 days prior to departure will be assessed a \$250.00 Cancellation Fee to cover administrative costs and advanced payments committed by the Center for International Studies. The application fee and any non-recoverable costs will also be forfeited. Withdrawal from the program must be done by completing a cancellation form and submitting it to the Center for International Studies located in Lawrence Hall.
