CANCELLATION POLICY: Students who withdraw from the program 60 days prior to departure will receive a full refund less the application fee and non-recoverable costs. The application fee and any non-recoverable costs will also be forfeited. **Withdrawal from the program must be done by completing a Cancellation Form and submitting it to the Center for International Studies.
