Program Objectives

The Greece and Italy program presents the opportunity for students to experience and observe sustainable city building and organization, alternative forms of transportation, economic/business practices, preservation efforts, tourism development, and other innovative practices that have allowed these places to survive the passing of time. This will allow students to compare and contrast comparable practices in the U.S., enriching their knowledge while integrating theory and practice.



Course Learning Objectives

Students will have two options. In option one, students will take the course **CMTY 410** (6 credits): *Built to Last and Planned to Endure: The Eternal Cities of Italy and Greece*. In option two, students will take the course **CMTY 466/566** (3 credits): *The Eternal Cities of Italy and Greece*. Students may only choose one option. Both courses are open to all students and can be used as University electives. However, the content of each course will be of most interest to students from Planning and Community Development, Geography, Travel and Tourism, Social Science Teachers Education, History, Economics, and Business. Each class will meet at least four times before departure for instructional and group building activities and will hold regular one-hour meetings also while on tour.

Program Costs & Financial Aid

Students pay a program fee set in accordance with prevailing on-campus costs and the value of the dollar in the host country.
