

Program Objectives

This program provides an opportunity for students to broaden their perspectives on the countries' social, cultural, and political affairs. Students will analyze race, ethnicity, class, and gender from a transnational perspective, and recognize the uniqueness and rich cultural heritages of the societies. This program also aims to broaden students' understanding of Lao/Thai/Malay ethnicity in a comparative analysis to Southeast Asian-American communities.









Course Learning Objectives

This course POL 495: Laos and Thailand Political Cultures is designed to provide students background information of animism, Buddhism, Islam, and European colonialism. These religious and political settings established the basis of the countries' social, cultural, and political institutions. In addition, the course will analyze how China, the newly emerging economic power in Asia, has attempted to influence these countries through economic activities and how the United States has counteracted to balance the Chinese influence in Southeast Asia.

Program Costs & Financial Aid
