Program Objectives

During this education abroad program, you will be introduced to cross-cultural psychology through classroom activities followed by comparative observational experiences in two countries. It is done so through a combination of academic reading, coupled with opportunities to observe, experience, reflect upon, and apply what students learn in the course as they compare and contrast Italy, Greece and the U.S.







Course Learning Objectives

PSY 330: *Cross Cultural Psychology* is a course that is suitable for all students who have an interest in, or wish to enhance their understanding of how culture influences behavior and thought. It will also enhance their ability to understand and function in our own, increasingly multicultural society.

Program Costs & Financial Aid

Cancellation Policy:

Students who withdraw or cancel from a program may be charged the full cost of program after the application deadline.
