University of Applied Sciences Wiener Neustadt (FHWN) Business Course Equivalencies

FHWN uses the ECTS credit system, which is a 2:1 ratio with US credits. Students take 30 ECTS per semester (15 US credits). Students will need to pair two courses together to full requirements for one HBS class.

This program is available for fall and spring, but will work best for students studying abroad for an entire academic year due to course pairings. This is a comprehensive list of courses that have been offered, but offerings are subject to change.

The International Office offers free language and culture classes. These are not required, but are highly recommended. Language courses fulfill Goals 6 and 8.
